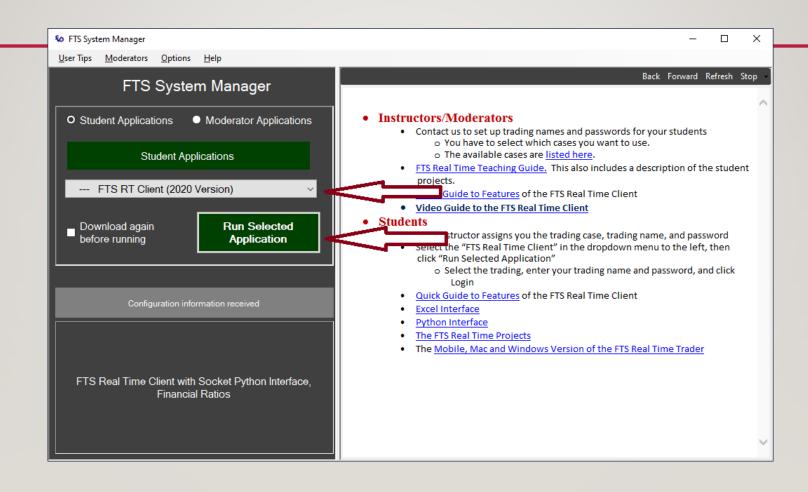
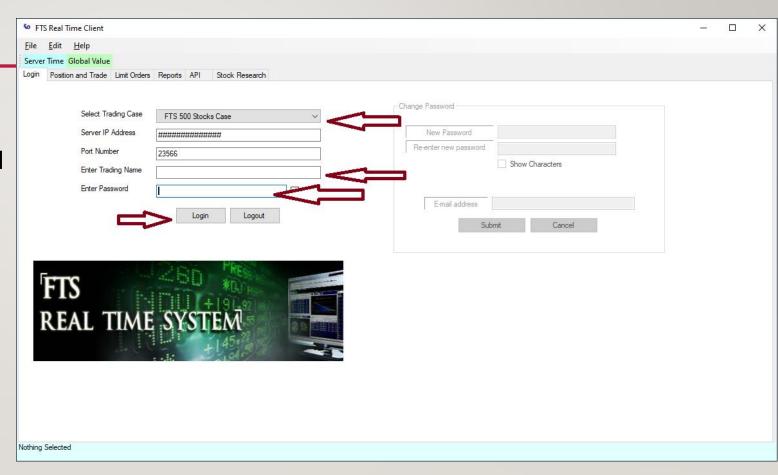

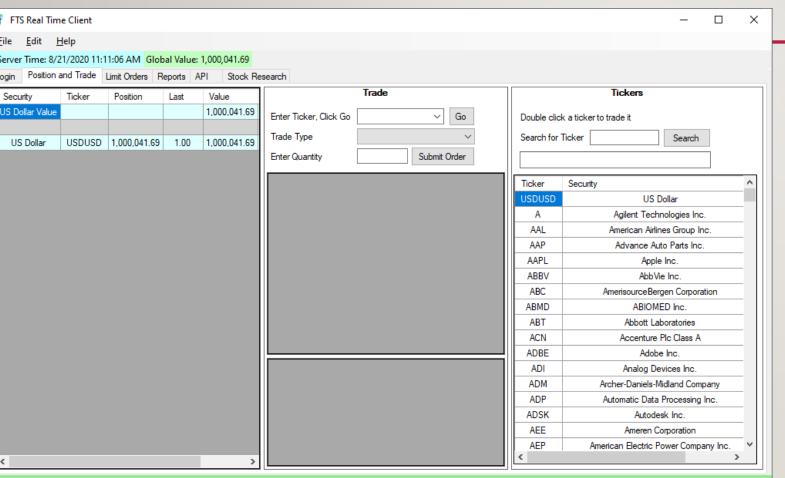


## LOGIN TO RTFTS

- Select your trading case
- Enter trading name, password
- Login

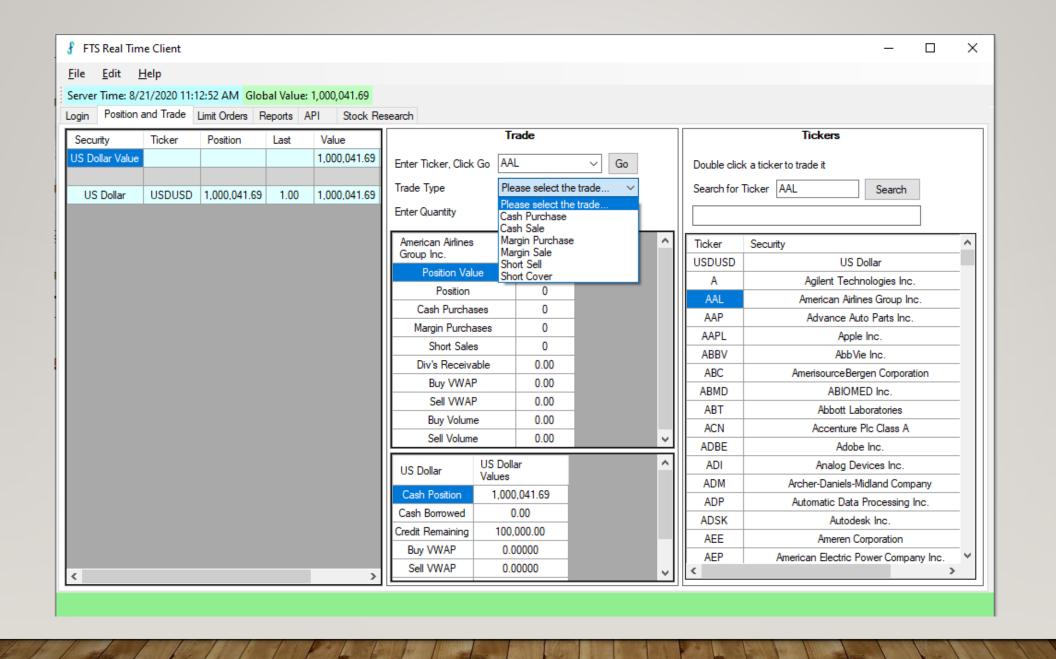


#### POSITION AND TRADE TAB

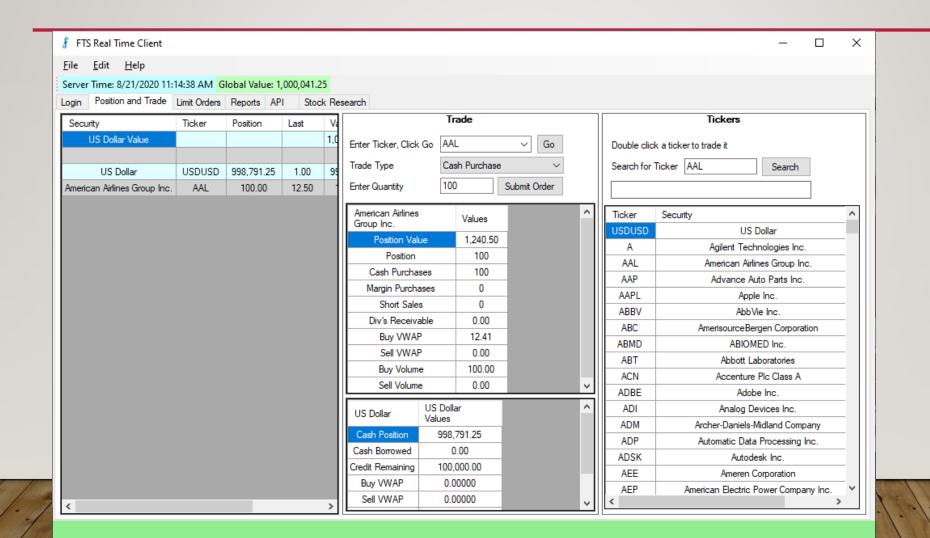


Enter a ticker in the dropdown and click Go or double click a displayed ticker. Available trade choices will appear. Select a trade, click "Submit Order"

These are "market orders"



## **EXAMPLE TRADE: BUY 100 SHARES OF AAPL**

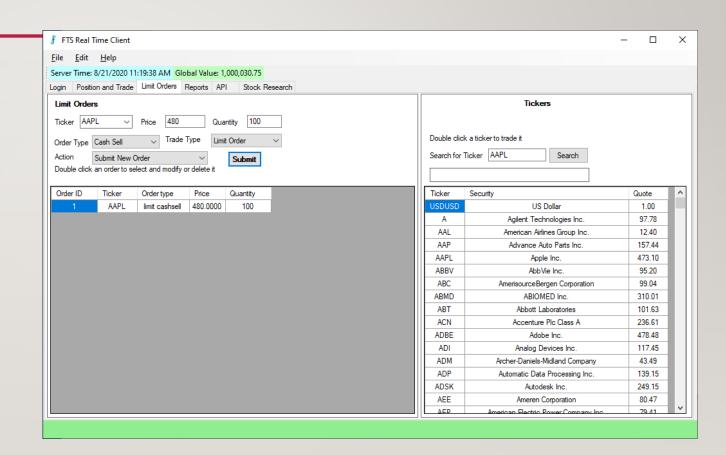


#### TRADE TYPES

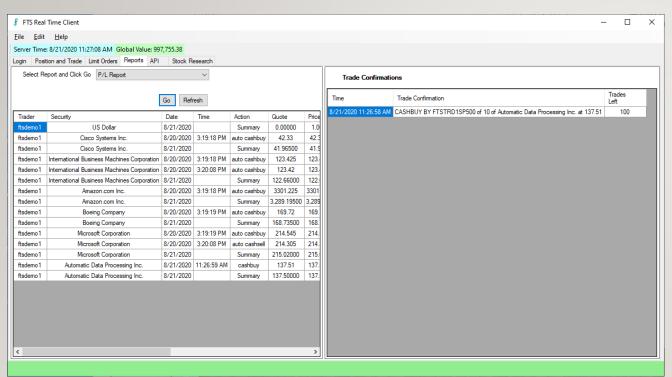
- Cash purchase: purchase with cash
  - Cash sale: sell shares previously purchased with cash
- Margin purchase: buy on margin
  - Margin sale: sell shares previously purchased on margin
- Short sale: establish a short position
  - Short cover: buy back shares previously sold short
    - Note: positions are netted, so if you have bought shares and then sell short, the shares you own are sold
      first and then a short position is established with any remaining shares

### LIMIT ORDERS

- Same as trading except you specify a limit price at which the trade is to be executed.
- You can submit a limit order, stop order, or a trailing stop order



#### REPORTS AND TRADE CONFIRMATIONS



- You can generate reports
  - End of day market values
  - Performance statistics
  - Relative performance
    - Relative to others in your section
  - P/L report as shown here
  - Instructors get reports for everyone in the section

#### API

- Allows you to connect to the FTS RT client with an external application
