



The FTS Display System lets you create displays for computers connected to large, high definition display monitors (or televisions). The program consolidates news and information from different internet sources with tickers and real time market graphs from FTS data servers to provide a rich display of news, financial news, sports, and entertainment. Every part of the display is customizable, and we provide supporting tools that let you create your own tickers etc.

The displays can be used anywhere, including trading rooms, student and faculty lounges, and or any public area where a public display is warranted. You can integrate school and department news into different parts of the display to provide a convenient solution for normal communications. The display can be “branded” with your logo.

Anyone who licenses the FTS System can use the FTS Display Program.
